Why they're important and which ones we cover

It is important to vaccinate your children against harmful illnesses that can cause long-term health problems. Vaccinations help children's immune systems to build antibodies against these illnesses, which will protect them should they ever come into contact with a particular infection.

Which vaccinations are covered by Blue Health Cover?

We cover certain vaccinations for children up to the age of 10 years old since they are shown to work, are cost effective and administering them is in line with local and international guidelines.

We cover vaccines to prevent the following illnesses:

- Tetanus
- Hepatitis B
- Diphtheria
- Haemophilus influenza type B
- Tuberculosis (BCG)
- Measles
- Mumps
- German measles (Rubella)
- Whooping Cough (Pertussis)
- Polio
- Pneumococcal infections

In addition, Blue Health Cover also pays for the influenza vaccine for both children and adults. The cost of this vaccine is paid from the Acute Conditions limit. We also cover the cost of Vitamin A supplements as part of this benefit as it has been shown to reduce complications related to measles and diarrhea.
